

When is the Healing Ministry open for prayer?

We are open for prayer on Wednesday evenings from 7pm - 8:30pm. We close for holidays and other special major events, so it is always best to call ahead of time to be sure that we are operating on the Wednesday evening that you prefer to come for prayer.

Do the Prayer Teams pray for any 'other needs' than physical healing?

Yes! We pray for any physical or emotional need: (such as past or current wounds of the heart); as well as any other concerns or requests that you may have, that can be addressed through prayer. What can I expect? EXPECT MIRACLES! Through faith and prayer, many people receive miraculous answers to all types of needs, including medically documented healing of various illnesses & diseases; financial needs; relationship restoration; salvation; baptism of the Holy Spirit; and much more. How often can I come back? As often as you would like too.

Do I need an appointment?

We would like for you to schedule an appointment so that we have a prayer team reserved just for you. Call the church office and dial O. The receptionist will schedule you for a date and time that is most convenient for you.

Do you take walk-ins?

Yes, but walk-ins are taken on a first-come, first-serve basis. We typically have several prayer teams in operation on any given Wednesday evening; however, typically many of those time slots are already filled with people who have reserved an appointment ahead of time. We will try to accommodate walk-in prayer needs, but please know that this is not something that we can guarantee.

Where do I go to receive prayer?

Enter through the main Worship Center doors and check in with the Healing Ministry receptionist (at the main Guest Services Desk in the Atrium). They will ask you to sign your name on the prayer request list for the evening. This list consists of people who are coming for prayer. You will fill out a very basic information sheet (such as your name and the prayer need you are requesting). This sheet is for our information only and is strictly confidential.

Who will pray for me?

We have wonderful prayer teams who are filled with love and compassion. Typically, you will be in a private room where three or four people who love God with all of their hearts, will pray for you for a time slot of approximately 30 minutes. The team will pray according to the direction of the Holy Spirit. We are not counselors, so we will do no counseling; we pray and believe.

Why do you do this?

We understand that often you need your brothers and sisters in Christ to stand in on your behalf to pound on Heavens doors to receive an answer to prayer. Our purpose is to petition heaven for your need; all you do is relax, stay in faith, and receive.

Who can receive prayer?

ANYONE! Saved or unsaved; churched or un-churched. We have people who drive from over an hour away to come in for prayer. Can I bring a friend into the prayer room with me? Yes! Bring along a friend or family member if you want the company with you! What Age? We pray for anyone of any age, from babies to seniors.
